

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
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Add/Maintain Booking Equipment

There are several ways equipment can be added to a booking.

- 1. Click on the item in the Tree View of the inventory
- 2. Search for the product code or description (See operational parameter 175 for default setting)
- 3. Manually key in the product code
- 4. At any point in the equipment grid Comment, Sundries and Heading can be added using the 'Add' 'Insert' buttons highlighted in the screenshot below.



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Comments allow free text comment lines to be added to the grid. These can be shown on any client facing or internal documentation.

Sundries are open charges where both the incurred cost and the client charge can be tracked. The details are open and can be changed on a booking by booking basis. See Booking operator privilege 'Can enter Sundry Items' to permit/prevent use of sundries by operators on the booking.

Headings allow for multiple equipment dates on the same booking. Headings are useful separators for breakout rooms, day separation, different functions for which normally a new booking would be required. Headings can have separate pricing, separate Delivery and Return dates.

Pricing

Once equipment is selected for the booking, adjustments can be made to the quantity, price, and discount for each line of equipment. Specific pricing models on a per line basis can be created. See Pricing documentation in knowledgebase for further information on pricing.

Taxes

Tax rates can be applied by clicking on one of the two tax boxes at the bottom of the screen. You can set up overall defaults that will apply to all new bookings as well as customer defaults (see customer properties) that will be applied anytime you select a certain customer. Clicking on the tax boxes in the booking will allow you to set a tax rate for a specific booking.



Discounts

Discounts can be applied to the entire booking; there is a separate overall discount for rental/hire and sales products.

- These will not conflict with any line item discounts. If a discount on the line already exists, the overall booking discount will skip the line amount and apply to other applicable lines.
- There are several other parameters and options that determine whether the extended price of a line is included in the booking discount. See Operational Parameter 90, Pricing parameters 9, 14, 15, 16, 43
- Lines that are not included in the overall discount will display a * beside the price. You can hover over the price with the mouse to see the reason the line is excluded from discount. (For instance a product may be set to "Do not discount" or you may not allow package products to be discounted).
- Only rental/hire and sales items are included in the discount, crew, delivery and sundries are not discounted.
- Operators can be restricted to a certain discount level so they can't apply a discount higher than their limit. You can set this in the operator setup area for each individual operator.

Equipment Grid Icons Explained

From the equipment grid, users have full availability checking. The Running Balance, Availability Calendar, and Product Plot Sheets are all available. From the **Running Balance** users can modify the priority of bookings. **Running balance** is only useful for single items, not package products.





Clear Enq	Clear E <u>n</u> q	Clears all items with 'Enq' (basically pricing enquiry) line item status

Backup	Backup	Changes the item type of the highlighted item to 'Backup', using the 'Backup' pricing as determined by Pricing Parameter 69. This is a toggle option, to change item back to normal simply click the backup icon again while highlighting the item on the equipment grid.
Analyze	Analyze	Profit Analysis (accessed from inside a booking) The Analyse button runs the Profit Analysis Report calculated profit margin for a booking. The report breaks down equipment, crew, PO's, and cross rentals. The results are separated into tax, pre tax, and total amounts.


